

Should election voting only be cast as i-votes?

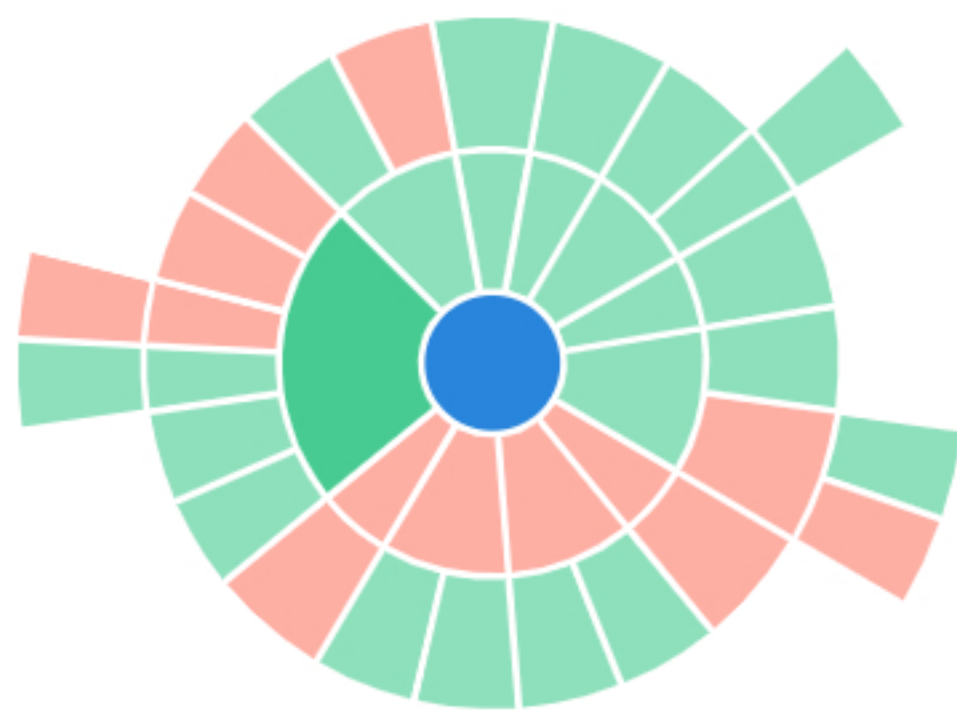

Background

The idea for i-votes (or remote e-votes) is to have voting happen through a electronic device (smartphone, computer, etc. to access the internet, maybe even a landline (not sure)). When they cast their vote, the website only lets them vote once. This would be different than the already existing paper voting: by mail, at an election polling location, or e-votes through electronic voting machines (see [e-votes vs i-votes](#)). These are not the focus here, but can be used as reference.
