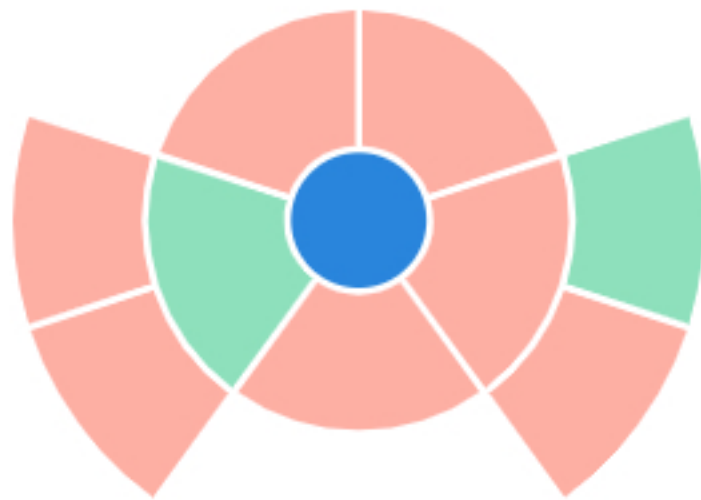
According to Merriam-Webster, **communism** is:
