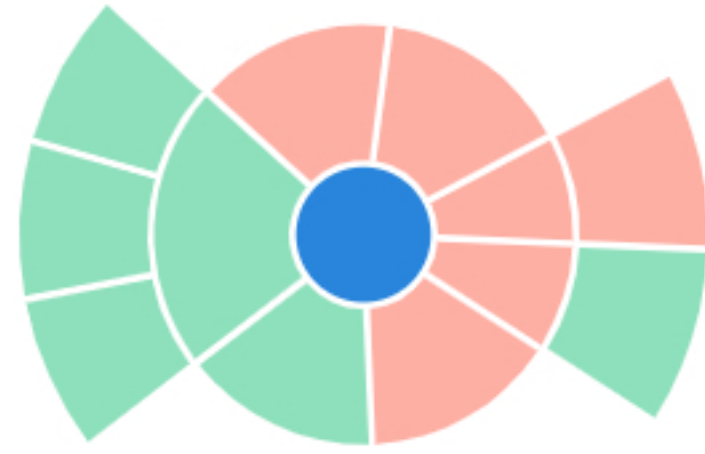
Background
