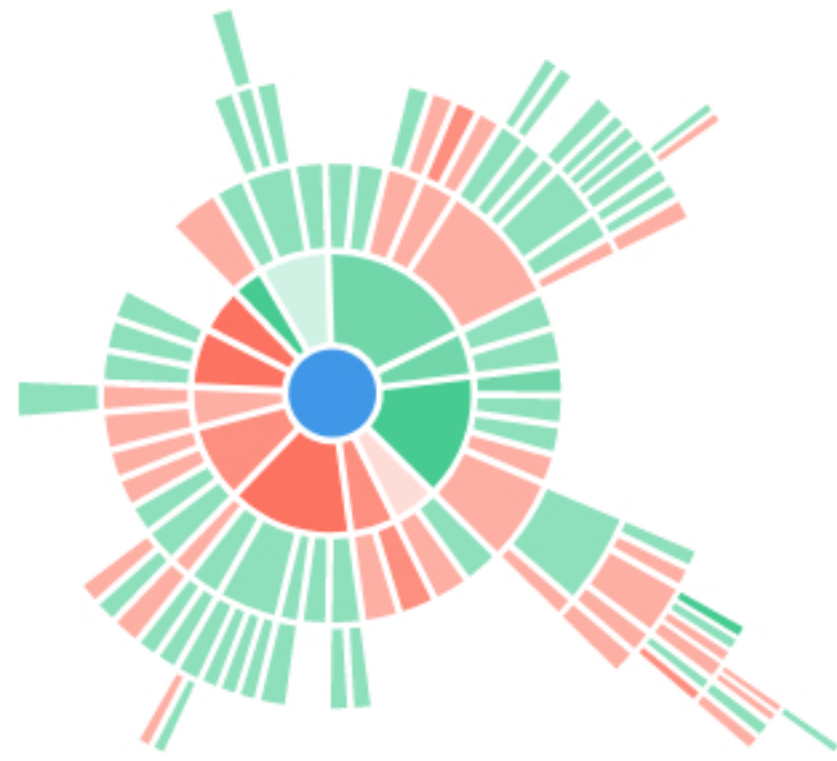
### Background
