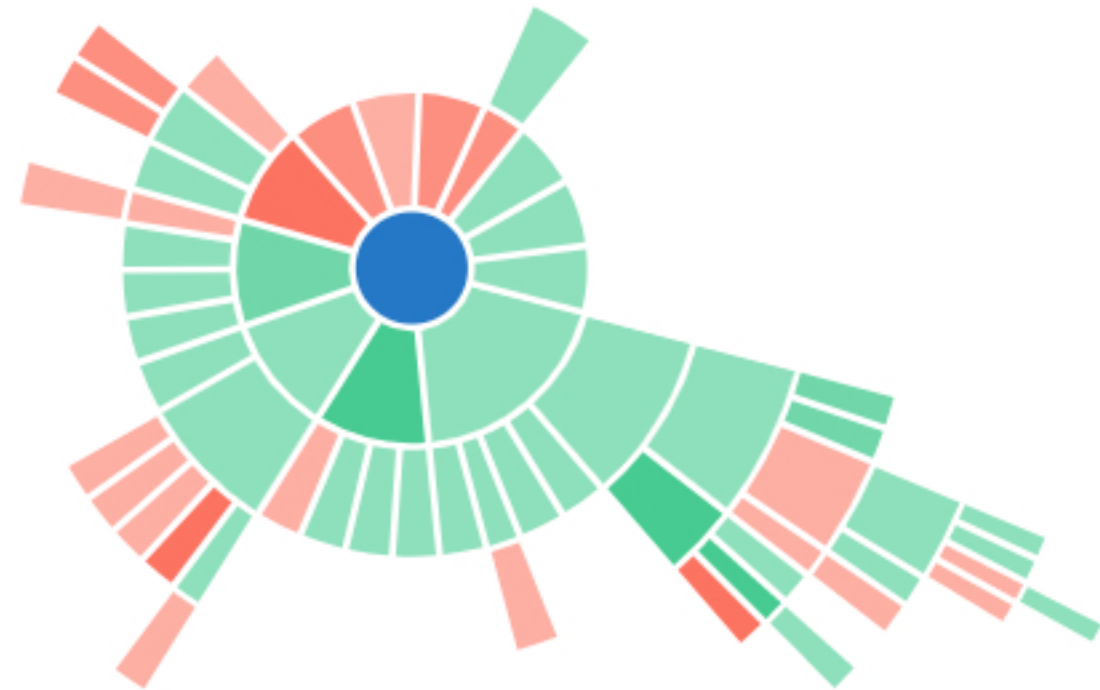
Background
