## Corona Becomes First Big Beer Brand to Trial Plastic-Free Rings

"Corona will pilot 100 percent <u>plastic</u>-free six pack rings in select markets—the first global <u>beer</u> brand to attempt the switch after <u>moves from smaller beer companies</u>.

The plant-based rings will be piloted in Tulum, Mexico—Corona's homeland—at the beginning of 2019.

Corona's move is part of a larger effort with the environmental organization <u>Parley for the Oceans</u> to switch to eco-friendly packaging to help curb plastic pollution, according to a <u>press release</u>."
