My criteria:

- what the company presents, sells, etc. (also applies to companies/brands they own), called APP:
 - applications: target industries (including food recipes)
 - product
 - partnerships: depends on how (i.e. getting a company that sells meat to get away from it is different than vice versa)
 - not included
 - real customers/workers that aren't vegan (unless they're the target audience or featured)
 - employee perks (like parties and vending machines, unless stated)
 - analytics of what animal industries do

Notes:

- Not every stock was looked at, so more may be added to the 'exploit' list (along with reasons why).
- It's important to look past vows to sustainability and health to their actions: visible in annual reports and 'solutions' or 'industries' of products.
- Also good to avoid Chinese stocks, due to their lack of animal rights in some areas there
