 - [Fully automated luxury communism \(FALC\)](#)
 - Resource-Based Economy ([RBE](#))

 - Digital token economy - new money, none from real/fiat money
 - Demonetization - i.e. digital economy
 - UBD (universal basic dividend) powered with blockchain technology it is immutable, fraud resistant and most suitable in the age of automation UBD is most adaptive in current socio cultural system! (But nevertheless very difficult to implement.)
 - A baby/breeder slot economy for the privilege of having a kid. With limitations on the size and energy expenditure of each person produced.

 - On-demand hybrid income (ODHI): Asking the government for money when needed, rather than a UBI, where everyone gets the same amount (unequally, instead of equally distributed).
 - Digitized [MMT](#)/[monetary market system](#) (a.k.a. fiat or physical money) for virtual environments
 - Creative/knowledge-based economy
 - Capitalism
 - Selectively given income (SGI)
 - No changes
 - Guaranteed jobs ([1](#), [2](#)).
