It allows for ideas to be 'fully fleshed out.'	Some say it creates an echo chamber.
Kialo allows for filtering of "noise" like spam and trolling before they appear on the website.	A lot of people don't know about it, and thus don't use it.

The dynamic capabilities on Kialo (editing others claims and the discussion/branch premises being changed) is <u>not favorable</u> for everyone.
Kialo debates are usually much more structured than they would be on other sites, thanks to its Pro/Con/Thesis design.
